In compliance with the requirements of the Laws of the State of Florida, and for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit, the undersigned does hereby acknowledge:

-). Name of Composition. The same of the corporation is SOLIVITA COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION, INC. ("Association").
- Principal Offigg. The initial principal office of Association is at the offices of Avatar Retirement Communities. Inc., which is located at 201 Albambra Circle. Com/ Gables. Florida 33134.
- 3. Registered Office Registered Agent. The street address of the Registered Office of Association is 201 Albambra Circle. Coral Gables. Florida 33134. The name of the Registered Agent of Association is: Donnis Getman. Esq.
- 4. Definitions. A declaration entitled Solivita Declaration (the "Declaration") will be recorded in the Public Records of Oscools County and/or Polic County. Florida, and shall govern all of the operations of a community to be known as Solivita. All initially capitalized terms not defined berein shall have size meanings set forth in the Declaration.
- Purpose of Association. Association is formed to:

- 7.5. To pay all Association Expenses including, but not lumited to, all licenses, taxes or governmental charges levied or imposed against the Community Property or other property of Association.
 - 7.6. To do all acts and make all payments required by the Club Plan.
- 7.7. To acquire (by gift, perchase, or otherwise), annex, own, hold, improve, build upon, operate, maintain, convey, grant rights and externents, selt, dedicate, lesse, treasfer or otherwise dispose of real or personal property (including the Community Property) in connection with the functions of Association except as limited by the Declaration. Without limiting the foregoing, if Club Owner is ever willing to sell the Club. Association may purchase the same without the joinder or consent of the Owners or any other person or activy.
